The Healing Place



Reach

We make it easy for people to get the help that they need. Clients can enter our overnight shelter and Sobering Up Center still intoxicated. This means they will not freeze in the winter or be on the streets while drunk or high. Additionally, our Sobering Up Center lightens the load on emergency rooms and **reduces everyone’s medical costs** by decreasing the number of indigent patients.

Recover

We are the only long-term recovery program in Virginia that provides services regardless of a client’s financial situation. This means people with major addiction problems and no resources **can get the help** they need **instead of being on the street or incarcerated.**

Restore


We provide a safe recovering environment as our men transition back to full-time employment and learn to live independently and successfully. This means **instead of active addicts** who are a tax burden, recovering addicts can become **tax-paying citizens.**

The Healing Place was brought to Richmond in 2005 when the Richmond Task Force on Homelessness identified a major need for addiction recovery resources for homeless men in Richmond. Successful Healing Place programs exist in Louisville, KY, Raleigh, NC, and Huntington, West Virginia. The Task Force chose the Healing Place model based on:

- Tremendous sobriety outcomes
- Cost effectiveness
- Ability to return tax-paying citizens to society

Meet Leslie

Leslie grew up on the mean streets of Long Beach, California during the late 60's and 70's. It was a "join or die" environment that almost ensured a life of lawlessness and drug abuse - gang membership was a foregone conclusion. He ultimately served 17 years in prison for bank robbery. He came out addicted, ill equipped for the job market and for productive living.

Eventually, Leslie wound up in Richmond knowing no one and having nowhere to turn. He entered the recovery program at The Healing Place. At The Healing Place he found hope, new life, and sobriety. He demonstrated a willingness to work hard and gained full time employment at a local HVAC company. He's been steadily promoted and entrusted with more and more responsibility.

He now spends much of his time giving back - helping men with addiction issues and similar backgrounds. He knows what it is to give back what was so freely given to him.
