This year's 34th annual **43<sup>rd</sup> Street Festival of the Arts** will take place on **September 13<sup>th</sup>**, **2025**, near Forest Hill Avenue and 43<sup>rd</sup> Street. The event will feature 75 of the region's finest contemporary artisans. An estimated 5,000 people attend the event, with many making it an annual fall tradition.

This RVA festival is intended to put a spotlight on the fine arts and crafts community in the area, to promote sales of local artisans and food vendors, and promote local musicians. The show is a true community effort benefiting CARITAS. Artisans donate work for a raffle, and proceeds of the artist-designed T-shirt help raise money for the event. The show is free to the public. However, donations can be made at each of the four entrances to the show. With the help of sponsorships, we have doubled our advertising budget, increased attendance, and increased the amount raised for CARITAS for this one-day event. Over the years, we have raised more than \$100,000 to help fulfill CARITAS's mission to create a safe space to heal and time to rebuild for those individuals experiencing homelessness and/or addiction.
